JobsOhio Certified Site

The Port Authority has worked with JobsOhio to list its 35-acre site among the elite industrial development sites in Ohio. The 35-acre rail-served site at the Port Authority's Aerospace Center obtained "SiteOhio Authenticated" status in January and is listed among just 16 sites achieving this ranking in Ohio. It's the only dual rail access site listed.

Potentia Financing Closes Deal

The Port Authority's financing capability has reached a milestone \$428 million in financings with the recent closing of the Kohl's Department Store incentive package. Kohl's \$66 million investment resulted in \$967,000 of sales tax savings converted to transportation infrastructure dollars provided to the Licking County TID.
