

PROJECT: WEST LOT PAVING



Shutdown of the West Parking Lots will occur the **afternoon of Friday, June 4** in order to prepare for a parking lot reconstruction project.

Starting Monday, June 7, work will began to mill the parking lots west and north of the 911 Center and the Horton Building. Weather-permitting, paving will began that same week and conclude inside of two weeks.

Roadways will also get re-paved. Traffic will be maintained in the main roadway.

Timing: Neff Paving reports that work should be accomplished, weather-permitting, before June 25, if not sooner.

Disruptions. For those who park or walk through this area, this project will require temporary disruption of parking and walking routines.

For those who work in the Boeing Building, the East Parking Lot is the suggested alternative. This is best accessed off of James Parkway.

For those who work on the west side of the campus, the North Parking Lot or "Pit" Parking Lot are recommended alternatives. Traffic here will be open.

Safety: Personnel should avoid walking and driving through the construction zone, even during times of a lull in construction activity. Surfaces may be tacky.

Benefits: Safety is the number one benefit. When complete, the reconstructed lots will better-address water runoff and pitted travelways will enjoy smoother surfaces. The walking path between the Horton Building and the North Lot will be striped for better delineation too. No parking spaces will be lost.



Impact Area. Orange and Yellow areas will close. Red areas will be impacted.
