

## Licking (OH) County + 2000 - 2009

### Summary

Jobs fell **6.9%** ↓ Sales fell **0.1%** ↓

Primarily, the job loss was caused by establishments that went out of business during this period causing a **15.4%** reduction of jobs. The number of job losses would have been greater if the expansions of existing companies had not added **7.8%** more jobs during the same period. About **0.8%** of job gains came from companies moving.
